Letters from Private A Tattersall to his parents across June 1915 to July 1916

My dear Mother and Father,

Well you will know by now that we are again our bit in the line.

We are having some cold weather just now and the ground is in a very sloppy state.

[--] are not very far from the enemies and in places can hear them doing work in the trenches. There are a lot of snipers in this part of [-] there is no danger fs you keep your head below the parapet. The Oldhams (24th) are in at present and they have lost a few men, killed and wounded.

The worst thing about these trenches is that we are always liable to bombing attacks, the reason for that being the trenches are so close. There is a lot of mining sound here, And [-] in reserve find parties to work them it is a bit of an experience going to work in one of these.
