<p><b>Source B</b></p> <p><b>Letters from Private A Tattersall to his parents across June 1915 to July 1916</b></p> <p>My dear Mother and Father,</p> <p>Well you will know by now that we are again our bit in the line.</p> <p>We are having some cold weather just now and the ground is in a very sloppy state.</p> <p>[--] are not very far from the enemies and in places can hear them doing work in the trenches. There are a lot of snipers in this part of [-] there is no danger fs you keep your head below the parapet. The Oldhams (24<sup>th</sup>) are in at present and they have lost a few men, killed and wounded.</p> <p>The worst thing about these trenches is that we are always liable to bombing attacks, the reason for that being the trenches are so close.
